# READY FOR BOOK EDITING?

You've done the hard work by putting pen to paper and shaping your ideas into a manuscript.

You start reviewing and editing your drafts. Again and again.

Then you tire of working with your draft.

--> That's the time to work with an editor!

You'll get outside perspective and feedback. Focusing on everything from the big picture to the small language details, a good editor will help you polish a draft into a gem.

## VALUE OF AN EDITOR

#### AN EDITOR WEARS SEVERAL HATS.

Editors should wear the hat of a...

- consistency checker.
- challenger.
- cheerleader.

All of these roles should lead to an optimized manuscript for you, the author.

#### WHY EDITING?

- Authors have important messages or expertise to share.

# VAL'S EDITING WORKFLOW

AU = Author

ED = Editor

#### INQUIRY

AU emails about project (word count, topic, target audience, and timeline). Sends sample to edit and/or schedules a consult.

#### SAMPLE EDIT

ED completes sample edit and responds with total cost and timeline.

Both ensure it's the right fit!

#### AGREEMENT

Both sign a contract and AU makes deposit.

# WORKFLOW, PART II

#### FIRST DRAFT

AU sends first draft by agreed upon date (in Word format).

# DEVELOPMENTAL EDIT

ED gives big picture feedback and suggestions about content, flow, and voice.

#### SECOND DRAFT

AU reviews the ED's feedback and schedules consult before updating the draft.

# WORKFLOW, PART III

#### TOUCH BASE

AU sends ED second draft and has a call if necessary. Discuss any updates to the timeline.

#### COPY EDIT

ED does detailed review to correct grammar, punctuation, adherence to style guide, etc.

#### FINAL VERSIONS

ED sends final version w/ tracked changes, a clean copy (changes accepted), and a style sheet.

# WORKFLOW, PART IV

WRAP-UP

AU and ED have a call if necessary.

FINAL INVOICE

AU pays final invoice per contract terms.

THEN...

AU works with cover designer, layout, proofreader, etc. before publishing!

## EXAMPLE TIMELINE

Send your inquiry 5 to 8 weeks before you would start editing.
Two rounds of QUALITY editing takes 6 to 7 weeks, depending on length and ED/AU turnaround times.

• Sample edit and agreement 2-3 business days

AU sends first draft
 Deposit paid before editing begins

Developmental edit 2 weeks

AU reviews and returns
 2-3 weeks

 Copy edit, wrap-up, final drafts, 2 weeks and final payments

Next, you'll send the manuscript for formatting, cover design, and proofreading. Then you launch your book!

## EDITING INVESTMENT

#### Example Pricing

 $30,000 \text{ words } \times \$0.06/\text{word}^* = \$1,800$ 

Val's range is \$0.04 to \$0.08 per word.

Nonrefundable deposit is typically 50% of total cost.

# HOW TO SAVE MONEY AND TIME

#### Space out your draft reviews.

• Give yourself at least a few days between draft reviews when possible. This allows you to read your work with fresh eyes and a refreshed brain.

#### Reverse outline.

 This is an outline of the whole manuscript, and it's done after you have a complete draft. In outline form, jot down a phrase or keywords from each section or paragraph. Review the outline and see if you need additional supporting ideas, can remove repetition, or should reorder content.

#### Find beta readers.

• Ask a trusted friend or colleague to read your book and give feedback. It's best if they are someone in your target audience or are familiar with your genre.
